

Tete – tete (French) - without the instruction of a third person, in intimate privacy **(e.g.)** There was a little chance of a <u>tete - a- tete</u>with Peter

Bona fide (Latin) - in good faith, genuine, real or legal, not false

(e,g.) The students have to obtain <u>bona fide</u> certificate from the college to get Bank loans.

Exempli gratia (Latin) -for example

(e.g.)Many are fond of popular pets, e.g. cat, dog, parrot, love birds etc.

De facto: (Latin) - in fact.

(e.g.) The corporate training is, de facto, useful to students.

Alma Mater:(Latin) - the college, school or university that once attended.

(e.g.) MIT, Chennai, is the Alma Materof Dr.AbdulKalam.

Per se:(Latin) - by itself or by themselves

(e.g.) The youth per seare more active.

Bona fide: (Latin) - (adjective) genuine, real

(e.g.) Only bona fide members of the company are allowed to use the logo.

Status quo:(Latin) - the existing state of affair

(e.g.) The rich show interest in maintaining their status quo.

Prima facie:(Latin) - first impression.

(e.g.) None should be punished based on prima facie evidence.
